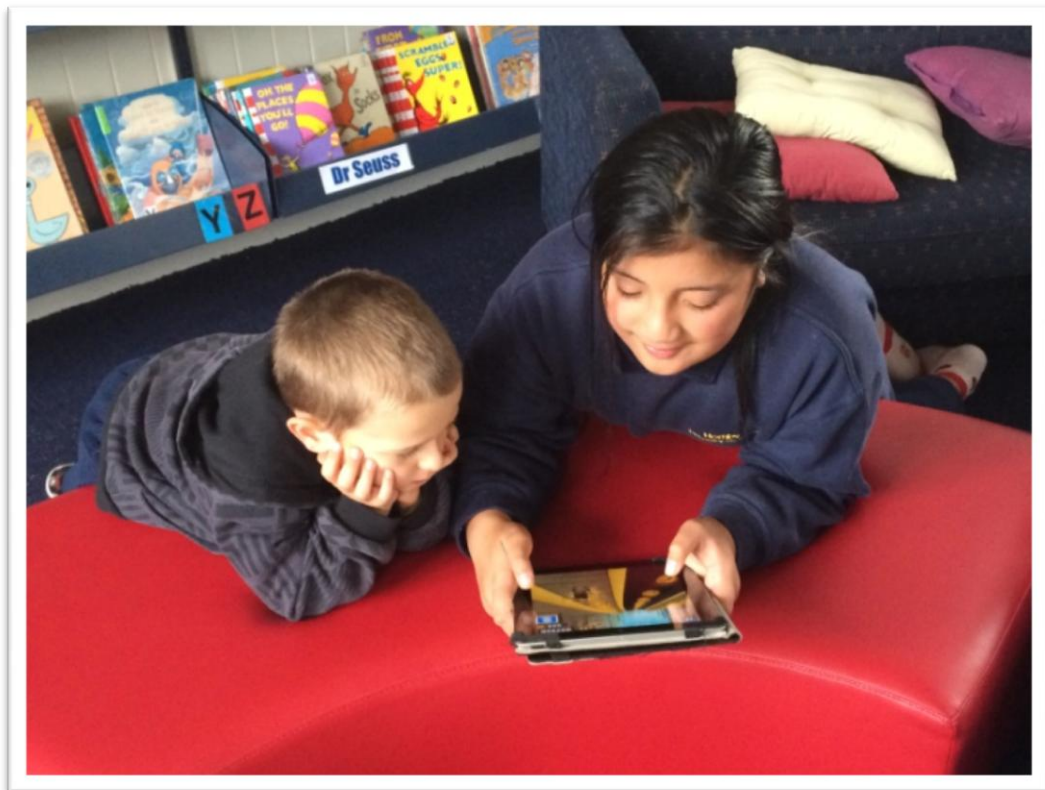

## Transition to School Playgroup

- Welcome to our transition to school playgroup. This playgroup is for you and your child/children who are starting at Hornby Primary School. We will focus on the transition for your new entrant child and your family into this School environment.
- The purpose of the playgroup is to provide the opportunity for your family to develop relationships within the school community.
- You will become familiar with the schools environment, protocol, practices, routines, and the key people in the school, i.e. principal, new entrant teacher, and other children and families.



## How does the transition playgroup support your child and family?

- Your family will have the opportunity to meet other families that are starting school at the same time, and develop relationships prior to their first day.
- As our playgroup will run through part of lunchtime they will experience the busyness of the playground. Children will have some time in the new entrants Classroom becoming familiar with where everything is.
- Parents/fanau will have the opportunity to question and gather information in regards to any particular needs and worries.
- Playgroup will start at 1pm finishing around 2.30pm every Wednesday and will run for a six week block every school term.
- Your child/children will meet and develop relationships with some of the senior children in the school who can help support them when they start school. We have several senior mentors who help out each week.
